**TEST COMMENTS:** *A wet, cold spring continued through the end of June, slowing crop growth early. Warmer temps from July through harvest encouraged vegetative growth and plant height. Mike's plot received 0.38" rain on Aug 13th, and another 0.4" in late Aug and early Sept. A frost occurred Sept 15th, but was not as severe here as in other areas.*
