

IMAGE COMMENTS: Despite looking good in mid-June, area rainfall was 6 to 7 inches below normal June through Aug. As the pictures show, corn plants were short and broken due to weak stalks and poor growth in the high heat, low moisture environment. Many plants had no ears. In one plot, I gathered all three developed ears shown in the bottom right picture. The plot border corn was 92-95 day RM. It developed ears when most of the plots later maturities didn't.
